Emphasis is placed on learning through play and interactive learning to promote the social, emotional, academic and physical development of each child. Cognitive, creative and physical activities are planned to foster this daily growth. An environment is provided that seeks to promote positive self esteem and social interaction. Our teachers provide constant encouragement so that the children become acquainted with the process of learning and are not concerned with the final outcome of their creations. We encourage all our children to learn to be independent.



Encouraging, nurturing, creative teachers, co-teachers, and a social worker are on staff to help identify children's needs and to assist parents and teachers with appropriate resources to maximize your child's potential.

Our nurturing educators provide each child scheduled feeding, diapering and resting opportunities incorporating language development and other learning experiences.

We will individualize the care of each child by getting updates via parent communications on your child's growth and development. Your updates will be used to assist the quality care of each child as well as to share developmental milestones.
